

# Vessel Temporary Permit

### Who can temporarily import a vessel?

Mexican and foreigners if they are the owners of a vessel.

The captain or his legal representative, can import only one vessel of 4½ meters long for entertainment or sports purposes.

The temporary permit also includes the machinery, the personal luggage and accessories that must be used for navigation and ornament of the vessel.

### How long does the permit lasts?

A period of ten years, with multiple entrances.

Importer may require a new permit for the same vessel, as long as he/she request it 15 days prior to the expiration of the last permit.

### Documents

- Mexicans with residence abroad or in Mexico: (original and copy).

Registration to vote, professional license, passport, immigration form, military service card, naturalization certificate, consulate certificate of registration or an official document that proves permanent residence abroad.

- Foreigners: (original and copy).

Passport, naturalization certificate, migratory documents issued by the Mexican Migration Institute showing their current migratory status or official Immigration ID in force.

If this require is made by a proxy, he has to present an appointment form signed by the property.

In addition you have to present the vessel title or the tenant document, such as:

- Vessel property title or invoice,
- Contract of affreightment
- Registration,
- Lease contract in the importers name
- A letter of credit or a proof credit payment

### Where can the permit be acquired?

- By Internet: [www.banjercito.com.mx](http://www.banjercito.com.mx), 60 days before your trip.
- At the Mexican Consulates in Albuquerque, Austin, Chicago, Dallas, Dallas Ftw., Denver, Houston, Los Angeles, Phoenix, Sacramento and San Bernardino. This step can be carried out at these Mexican Consulates six months in advance.
- At Banjercito offices (CIITEV Modules) located at the Mexican border

### How much does it cost?

It's \$49.50 USD, in cash or presenting international credit or debit cards issued abroad and with the importers name.

Plan your trip and request information in advance!

We are all obliged to comply with these Customs provisions. If you feel that you are being subject of a corruption act please denounce it immediately.
